

## RESOLUTION ON VOTER FRAUD

Whereas, The Republican Party of Texas supports the elimination of voter fraud, calling for stiffer penalties for persons involved in it, and

Whereas, the current misdemeanor status of the act is tantamount to no deterrence at all, and

Whereas, the legislature in the last session passed a strong anti-voter fraud bill out of the House with overwhelming support, and

Whereas, HB1463 is currently being held up in the Elections Committee, which committee is composed of a majority of Republican members, and

Whereas, this Bill has great support in the people of this State and will have great support in the legislative body of the House,

BE IT RESOLVED, we encourage the Republican members of the House Elections Committee to pass HB1463 out of the House Elections Committee and permit the bill to reach the floor of the House.
