

Resolution by the Texas State Republican Executive Committee Encouraging Educational Integrity at Texas Universities

Whereas, the 2006 State Republican Platform defines marriage as the sacred union between one natural man and one natural woman, and the Sexuality and Gender Committee of the Office of Diversity and Community Engagement {O.D.A.C.E.} at the University of Texas at Austin advocates that the University grant spousal rights to same sex students and staff of the University, while demanding uni-sex restrooms for transvestites, homosexual studies and major degree studies in homosexuality, and

Whereas, the Platform also states that all individuals have the right of free speech and that the University of Texas at Austin has declared that certain words and phrases are hate speech and shall result in disciplinary action, and

Whereas, the Platform demands responsible stewardship of all public funds and resources and the University of Texas at Austin O.D.A.C.E has increased staff from eight to one hundred and fifty employees in two months with no accounting for the size of the budget, nor the means of funding said group, and

Whereas, the Platform rejects quotas and reverse discrimination, and the O.D.A.C.E has but one purpose to advance those who have not met the stringent criteria for admission to the University, and

Whereas, the Platform promotes Judeo-Christian values and the O.D.A.C.E. promotes hedonism and dangerous behavior, therefore

Be It Resolved that, the Texas Republican Executive Committee encourages the Legislature to refuse to fund O.D.A.C.E. and other diversity groups at all State institutions of higher learning, and

Be it further resolved, that the State Republican Executive Committee encourages the Legislature to investigate the restraint of free speech on Texas campuses and refuse state funds to those institutions that punish responsible, intelligent and open discussion, and

Be it further resolved, that the State Republican Executive Committee encourages the Legislature and the Governor to direct all Boards of Regents remove all reverse discrimination and quota systems from their respective institutions immediately, and

Be it further resolved, that a copy of this resolution be immediately forwarded to the Governor, Lt. Governor, members of the Texas Legislature, members of the Higher Education Coordinating Board, and the offices of the University Systems Chancellors.
