

Resolution Concerning Trans-Texas Corridor

Whereas, SB1267/HB2772 currently pending in the Texas legislature would place a 30-month moratorium on the execution of Comprehensive Development Agreements (CDAs) governing the operation of and collection of toll revenue on segments of the Trans-Texas Corridor by private entities and would appoint a study committee to evaluate the public policy implications of entering into a CDA with a private entity and of selling an existing toll project to a private entity;

Whereas, 25 of 31 State Senators and 107 of 150 State Representatives have signed on in support of SB1267/HB2772;

Now, therefore be it resolved that the Republican Party of Texas strongly supports and urges the passage of SB1267/HB2772 and further calls on Senator Corona, Chair of the Senate Committee on Transportation & Homeland Security, to expeditiously move consideration of this crucial legislation.

Be it further resolved that a copy of this resolution be sent to Governor Perry, Lt. Gov. Dewhurst, and all Texas state legislators.
