

Grassroots Focus on Dave Davis

A life-long Republican, Dave became passionately involved in politics after the 2000 election by becoming a poll worker and then an election judge and also started attending Arlington Republican Club meetings. It was at one of these meetings when he volunteered to work on a Constable campaign. After attending his first precinct convention in 2004, he became a delegate to the SD9 Convention and served on the nominations committee in both 2004 and 2006 as well becoming a delegate to the State Conventions in 2004 and 2006.

Ever since that first Constable campaign, Dave has been involved in one campaign or another, including a City Council race, State Rep. contest, and the 2004 Presidential race, doing everything from making phone calls and knocking on doors, to chairing committees and working at campaign headquarters.

Upon moving into SD10, Dave was appointed the non-ratified Precinct Chair of his precinct and, since this last primary election, is now the current precinct chairman of precinct 2505. He has recently hosted two precinct meetings in his effort to grow the grassroots in his area by inviting candidates as well as local party leadership. Interest in his precinct is definitely growing, having gone from minimal representation in past SD10 conventions to six delegates this year, three of whom will be representing SD10 at the State Convention in Houston.

Dave and his wife Felicia are both 1989 graduates of Texas Tech University. Upon graduation, Dave was commissioned as a Naval officer; he was a pilot for nine years. He is now a captain at a major airline. They are the proud parents of a 13-year-old boy and 9-year-old girl.
